For rough skin on the elbow, knee, and heel, etc.

エクテマ® クリーム ECTEMA Cream

Emollient

Moisture and moist smooth feeling

Urea, the main ingredient of ECTEMA Cream, makes the layer of skin of elbow, knee, and heel moist and smooth.

Precautions

When not to use the product (If you do not follow these instructions, the current symptoms may worsen or adverse reactions are more likely to occur.)

*The medicine should not be used on the following parts.

- ① Periorbital area, mucosa (oral cavity and nasal cavity, etc.), etc.
- ② Lesions with scratch wounds and fissures (crack areas)
- ③ Lesions where skin comes off like a scab
- ④ Lesions with an inflammation (erosion, red swelling)

Consultation

1. The following persons should contact a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation before administration.
 - ① Patients undergoing medical treatment from a physician.
 - ② Patients who have experienced allergic symptoms associated with drugs, etc.
2. If the following symptoms are observed after using this drug, these may be adverse reactions, so immediately discontinue the use, and show this document to your physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson for a consultation.

Areas Concerned	Symptoms
Skin	Rash/Redness, Itching, Contact dermatitis, etc.

3. When symptoms do not improve even after using this medicine for 2 weeks, stop using this medicine and consult a physician, pharmacist or registered salesperson, being sure to take this instruction leaflet with you.

Indication

Rough skin on the hand/finger, keratosis of elbow/heel/ankle, and dry skin of elders

Dosage and administration

Take an appropriate amount and apply to the affected lesion several times a day.

Precautions of dosage and administration

- ① Attention should be paid so that the medicine will not come into contact with eyes. In case the medicine comes into contact with eyes, immediately rinse them with water or lukewarm water, and immediately seek an ophthalmologist for medical treatment.
- ② When allowing children to use the medicine, a guardian must be present to watch and tell such them how to use it.
- ③ The medicine is only for external use and should not be internal use.

Ingredient and amount per 100g

Urea··· 20g

Additives··· Glycerin, Stearyl alcohol, Propylene glycol, Polyoxyethylene hydrogenated castor oil, Glyceryl monostearate, White petrolatum, Paraben

Precautions for storage and handling

- ① Seal hermetically and store in a cool place away from direct sunlight.
- ② Keep out of reach of children.
- ③ Do not transfer the medicine to a different container. (It may lead to misuse or alter the quality of the drug.)
- ④ Do not use any medicine after the expiration date which is indicated on the box.
